

**Mutual responsibility agreement between the
NURSERY/PRESCHOOL MANAGING DIRECTOR AND THE FAMILIES OF THE ENROLLED PUPILS
Regarding organizational, health and hygiene measures and individual behaviors aimed at containing the spread of
the Covid-19 contagion.**

both parties aware of the civil and criminal consequences in the case of false statements, SIGN THE FOLLOWING CO-RESPONSIBILITY AGREEMENT REGARDING THE ATTENDANCE OF _____ AT THE AFOREMENTIONED NURSERY/PRESCHOOL.

SPECIFYING THAT THE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN, IN PARTICULAR, **aware that in the pediatric age infection is often asymptomatic or paucisymptomatic**, in agreement with the necessity for a strong alliance between the parties involved, and effective and timely communication in the case of suspected symptoms

DECLARES

- to be aware of the contagion containment measures in force as of today;
- that the child attending the institution or a cohabitant within the same family unit is not subjected to the measure of quarantine or that he/she has not tested positive for Covid-19;
- to self-monitor his/her own health, that of the child, as well as that of all cohabitants within the same family unit, and to seek medical support from the family physician and pediatrician.
- **each time A parent, child, or any cohabitant presents suspected symptoms of COVID-19 (for example: fever, (equal to or greater than 37.5 ° C) or other symptoms such as sore throat, cough, nasal congestion, conjunctivitis, loss of smell or taste, diarrhea, vomit, breathing difficulty etc.) he/she will:**
 - **not access the school premises**, and communicate the child's absence to the school for health reasons;
 - promptly return home;
 - contact the family physician/pediatrician to evaluate the case in order to activate the procedure for the nasopharyngeal swab test;
- accept that his / her child will be subjected to measuring the temperature using a noncontact thermo scanner at the entrance to the school structure, and that, in the event of a temperature equal to or greater than 37.5 °C or in the presence of other symptoms, including those mentioned above, will not be admitted;
- be aware and accept that, in the event of a fever (temperature equal to or greater than 37.5 °C or other symptoms (as mentioned above), the school will provide for the isolation of the child in a dedicated space until the arrival of the family member who will be informed by the school staff to remove the child and asked to seek immediate medical assistance from the family physician/pediatrician to evaluate the case in order to activate the diagnostic procedures; be aware that with school attendance the health and hygiene directions must be respected;

● have been adequately informed by the institute of the organizational and sanitary provisions for the safety and for the containment of the risk of spreading the Covid-19 contagion and in particular:

○ of the provisions for accessing and exiting the facility;

○ to not access the premises, except for specific cases in accordance with the guidelines for reopening institutions serving children of 0-6 years of age;

● commit to adopting precautionary behavior to minimize the risk of infection during the times and in the places the child spends time while not at the school;

● be aware that with the resumption of interaction activities, even if they are regulated, it is not possible **to eliminate the risk of infection which instead should be reduced to a minimum through the scrupulous and strict observance of the safety and precautionary measures laid out in the regional guidelines as indicated above, and for this reason it is important to use extreme caution outside the school setting, as well.**

IN PARTICULAR, THE MANAGING DIRECTOR, aware that in the pediatric age infection is often asymptomatic or paucisymptomatic, in agreement with the necessity for a strong alliance between the parties involved, and effective and timely communication in the case of suspected symptoms

DECLARES

● to have examined the “guidelines for the reopening of institutions serving children aged 0-6” as laid out by the Veneto Region and to abide by the directions contained within, in compliance with the actions taken and security measures for the prevention and containment of the spread of SARS-CoV-2;

● to have contextually provided punctual information at the time of enrollment regarding the organizational, and health and hygiene directives adopted to contain the spread of the COVID-19 contagion, and to commit to communicating eventual modifications or additions to the directives;

● to gain assistance from persons adequately trained in all of the aspects in reference to the norms in force regarding the organization of nursery/preschools, in particular the hygiene and health procedures to counteract the spread of infection;

● to commit to implementing the procedures regarding school entrances and the adoption of all health and hygiene procedures as foreseen by the regional guidelines and the norms in force;

● to organize the activities in the best possible way to avoid interaction between different groups of children;

● to strictly and scrupulously comply, in the case of proven Covid-19 infection by pupils or adults attending the facility, at any disposal of the local health authority;

The signing of this agreement commits the parties to respect it in good faith. From a legal point of view, it does not free the subjects who sign it from any liability in the event of failure to comply with the regulations relating to the containment of the Covid-19 epidemic, the ordinary regulations on safety in the workplace and national guidelines for the safe management of social interaction and play time of children during the COVID-19 emergency, and the resumption of activities in an educational setting at nursery/preschools in accordance with the abovementioned regional guidelines for the reopening of nursery/preschools.
